# Why Join the Chamber of Commerce?

For many members, the Chamber offers a welcome opportunity to get together with like-minded people and discuss the achievements and challenges of business life. The Chamber provides many opportunities to build your network and open up a world of opportunities to raise your profile in Peacehaven and the surrounding area.

#### **Established Organisation**

The Peacehaven & District Chamber of Commerce is an established organisation launched in February 2007 by the then Mayor of Peacehaven, Cllr Elayne Merry. The Chamber quickly established itself as the area's premier business support and networking organisation. Since then it has become a respected organisation, representing the interests of local businesses in the South Coast area. Today, membership is drawn largely from Peacehaven and Telscombe Cliffs but as a testament to the strength of the Chamber, members are joining from Newhaven, Seaford, Lewes, Brighton and even as far away as Portslade.

#### **Breakfast Club Networking Meetings**

The heart of the Peacehaven & District Chamber of Commerce are our bi-weekly Breakfast Club networking meetings. Held on the first and third Tuesdays of the month, the meeting offers our members the opportunity to relax and enjoy informal networking with fellow members, promote their business and listen to informative and inspirational speakers. The meetings are held between 7:00 and 8:30 in the morning to avoid interfering with your working day.

 Network with business owners in the local area – Building a network of contacts can really help to promote your business. Word of mouth referral is one of the best adverts



for your business, and by sharing what you do with our members helps them to refer new business to you.

- Promote your business in our one-minute round Your opportunity to give a brief overview of your business to other members and guests.
- Referrals and Testimonials Pass referrals to other members and an opportunity to thank and recommend fellow members for work they've done.
- Listen to the speaker of the day At the end of each meeting, one of our members has
  an opportunity of showcasing their business in a twenty-minute presentation.
  Occasionally we invite an outside speaker, to come and give a presentation on topics
  relevant to the local area and residents.



#### Online Member's Directory

The Peacehaven Chamber website carries a Member's Directory, which is available to internet users looking for local services. Our members can upload a short overview of their business and the services they offer. The Members Directory has a space for logo and banner images, website & social media links as well as contact details. Inclusion in our online directory creates an association of your brand with the trusted organisation that is the Peacehaven & District Chamber of Commerce, adding credibility to your business as well as helping the search engine optimisation (SEO) ratings of your own website.



#### **Social Media Promotion**

The Chamber use social media to promote and publicise events and businesses. Regular updates are posted through Facebook, Twitter and email.

#### **Monthly Information Newsletter**

A monthly Newsletter is produced giving members access to all the current information on grants, fundings and items of interest.

#### **Events Board**

A monthly Events Board highlighting all upcoming events both social and business.

#### **Spotlight Your Business**

A monthly advertisement for members to Spotlight their business in depth which is shared to all members and non-members.

#### Shape the Future of the Local Area

The Peacehaven and District Chamber of Commerce are heavily involved in shaping the future of our local area. The Chamber regularly provides input to local governmental organisations such as East Sussex County Council (ESCC), Lewes District Council (LDC) and Sussex Police, where we provide a voice for local businesses in meetings. As a member you can share in awareness of local issues and events, and influence key local groups through representation by the Chamber of Commerce, an organisation that represents a unified voice for the local business community.

#### Seahaven Business Awards

The Seahaven Business awards is a business awards evening jointly run with the Newhaven and Seaford District Chambers of Commerce. The awards evening is an annual event that has been running since 2003 and features an awards ceremony and dinner attended by local business owners, local dignitaries such as mayors of the local towns, the Vietnamese Ambassador to the UK, who has a connection to Newhaven and the Deputy Lord Lieutenant of East Sussex. The awards are centred around seven awards categories from 'business person of the year' through to 'best eatery'. The Chamber encourages its members to apply for the awards, and we have had many successful winning members through the years. Being an award winner provides a major boost to promoting your business. Winners are interviewed on local radio and featured in the local press and can also promote their win by the use of winner's banners on any advertising they do.





#### Social Events & Visits to Local Areas of Interest

There's time for a bit of fun too! There have been many Chamber organized social events over the years. Whether organised by the Peacehaven and District Chamber or jointly run with neighbouring chambers such as Newhaven and Seaford Chambers, the events provide a means of socialising and networking with other business owners at an entertaining occasion. Past events have ranged from the competitive, such as golfing days, go-karting or bowls evenings through to informative visits to local sites such as the Rampion Wind Farm or the Newhaven Incinerator. Through our programme of events, you can meet with potential clients and suppliers as well as network with other Peacehaven and South Coast business people who can help you out with information, support and contacts in a fun and relaxing environment.

#### **Membership Clarification**

#### One Business per Membership

When you join the Peacehaven and District Chamber of Commerce, it is your **business** that becomes the member, not the individual. This means that if you operate more than one business and would like to promote each of them—both in our online member directory and during your 60-second pitch slots—**each business would need its own separate membership**.

Of course, if you have multiple businesses but choose to promote only one, that's absolutely fine. In that case, your membership would be associated with that single business, and only that business would appear in the directory and be eligible for your 60 second pitches.

Some of our members do run multiple businesses and choose to take out multiple memberships. This entitles them to have each business listed individually on our website and gives them a 60-second pitch opportunity at breakfast for **each** of their businesses.

# Joining the Chamber, Annual Fee & Payment Options:

#### Option 1 - Monthly payment via standing order

Most of our members choose to pay their membership by monthly standing order. A payment of £35 per month includes your payment for breakfast at our bi-weekly Breakfast Club Meetings, which effectively means you're getting your membership fee for free! (Breakfast meetings take place every  $1^{st}$  and  $3^{rd}$  Tuesday of the month).

#### Option 2 – Annual payment (Full Membership)

For businesses based in, or supplying products and services to, Peacehaven and the surrounding area.

Single payment of £120.00 paid annually on the date of joining

#### Option 3 – Annual payment (Affiliate Membership)

For voluntary organisations, not-for-profit sector, charities, schools & colleges, social enterprises.



Single payment of £60.00 paid annually on the date of joining

#### For members paying via options 2 or 3

Please note - Your membership fee does not include the cost of your breakfast at our bi-weekly Breakfast Club. The Breakfast Club meetings requiring a cooked/cereal/yoghurt breakfast will require payment of £17.50 (£15.00 for affiliate members) each time you attend. You will be asked to book in advance in the usual way.
